To whom it may concern:

This letter is a follow up to your inquiry concerning the amount of recycled material in Western Tube’s pipe and conduit products.

The pipe and conduit products manufactured by Western Tube Company are produced from approximately 25% to 85% recycled steel. The amount can vary depending on the steel vendor. Of the 25 to 85% recycled steel approximately 30% is pre-consumer (or post-industrial) and 70 % is post-consumer depending on fluctuating scrap prices. The American Iron and Steel Institute (AISI) website states: “Steel’s recycling rate of 69% is far higher than that of any other material capturing twice as much tonnage as all other materials combined.”

Western Tube has manufacturing facilities in the following locations: Rochelle, Illinois, Wheatland, Pennsylvania; Warren, Ohio; Cambridge, Ohio, Chicago, Illinois, and North Kansas City, Missouri.
